

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy entails how **Foamblock LTD** (“**Foamblock**” or “**we**” or “**us**”) processes personal data and provides information about our policies and practices on the collection, use, and disclosure of the data relating to you; your access to and use of our website (<http://foamblock.eu>).

This Privacy Policy applies to personal data and other information we collect for ensuring the best experience with our website and replying to your queries. Please be advised that should you not opt to share your data with us, we might be unable to respond to your request.

Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (“**data subject**”); an identifiable natural person is the one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

WHAT INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We may request and collect some types of data from our users such as their name, email address, telephone, cellular and other wireless device address, and other contact information through various means such as contact form.

When you contact us for any reasons, you might be asked to provide certain personal information, which may include your name, email address, and phone number (landline and/or mobile). It is always your choice whether or not to provide us with such personal information. However, if you do not provide the necessary information you may not be able to access some or all of the features of the service you are requesting. We might be unable to respond to your request due to the lack of information.

Non-Personal Information.

Cookies and Other Tracking Technology. As with many websites, we may use “cookies” to keep, and sometimes track, information about you. Cookies are small data files that are sent to your browser or related software from a web server and stored on your computer’s hard drive. Cookies track where you travel on a website and what you look at and may purchase. A cookie may enable us to relate your use of our Site and other information about you. All of these purposes serve to improve and personalise your experience on our Site.

Certain cookies are essential for the operation of a website. Other cookies are used to compile aggregate and statistical data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer a better website experience and tools in the future. Typically, these “analytics” cookies do not need access to personal information for their operations.

We may contract with third-party service providers to provide these analytics services. They are contractually prohibited from using personal information collected on our behalf except to help us conduct and improve our business.

Third party cookies. Our website hosts cookies of WIX.

Opting Out of Cookies. In general, you have the ability to accept or decline most cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. Note, however,

“essential” cookies cannot be disabled. Foamblock currently uses essential cookies only.

IP Address and Clickstream Data. In addition, our server may automatically collect data about your server’s Internet address when you visit us. This information, known as an Internet Protocol address, or IP Address, is a number that’s automatically assigned to your computer by your Internet service provider whenever you’re on the Internet. When you request pages from one of our website sections, our servers may log your IP Address and sometimes your domain name. The pages you visit on our website; other information about the type of web browser, computer, platform, related software and settings you are using; and other web usage activity and data logged by our web servers. We use this information for internal system administration, to help diagnose problems with our server, administer our website, and identify our users. We may also use such technologies to remember user preferences or minimise the need for you to re-enter information. Such information may also be used to gather broad demographic information, such as country of origin and Internet Service Provider. We may also link this information with your personal data that you have provided to us.

HOW WE USE AND SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may use personal data collected on and through our website in the course of our business (by responding to your request) and as otherwise set forth herein. For example, such information may be used to process your requests and orders, respond to your inquiries.

DATA SECURITY

Foamblock has implemented reasonable and appropriate security measures and steps to ensure the security of the Personal and other information we collect. Any third-party service providers with whom we may share personal information are contractually obligated to implement security measures no less robust and comprehensive. However, be advised that no method of transmitting or storing electronic data is ever completely secure, and we cannot guarantee that such information will never be accessed, used, or released in a manner that is inconsistent with this policy.

Information collected is stored for the period established by the legislation as a proof of rendered services. Information provided through the contact form is stored for 1 calendar year starting from the date on which it was shared with us. This information is not shared with third parties and is controlled by us in its entirety.

HOW TO ACCESS & CONTROL YOUR PERSONAL DATA

The processing of personal data is made in accordance with the provisions of REGULATION no. 679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and

repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Directive) and you enjoy the rights set out in Chapter III, namely:

- You have the right to access your personal data
- You can request rectification or deletion (with certain limitation)
- You can request restriction of processing
- You can withdraw your consent
- You also have the right to object processing, and the right to portability of data subject to compliance with the legal provisions for processing data.

We use your consent for deploying cookies and for the data provided through our contact form.
